### About the team

The Reviews and System Capability business group serves as an integrated, professional, and thought-leading advisory group to the government. The business group is responsible for strategically and operationally leading key programmes of work by:

- Uplifting regulatory system capability using a variety of interventions and mechanisms; and
- Improving regulation and regulatory systems by undertaking targeted reviews of varying scope and scale.



### About the role

The Reviews and System Capability group manages a pipeline of work where project teams are assembled from across the business group based on the scope and scale of each piece of work, ensuring a blend of skills and expertise is brought together as needed.

The Advisor is responsible for supporting regulatory reviews, investigation and/or capability-building activities within an operating model where expertise may be drawn from across the group.

Under the guidance of the senior members of the team, the Advisor will contribute to the Ministry's broader initiatives, approaches and strategies.

As a small and agile Ministry, the Advisor will be expected to contribute to other work priorities and tasks as needed.

The individual's specific responsibilities and focus will evolve over time to align with the Ministry's and the Minister for Regulation's changing priorities.

### **About you**

- Curious with sound critical thinking, reasoning, and judgement, and the ability to apply this in a policy or regulatory context
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, along with numerical and/or data literacy, with the ability to communicate issues and concepts clearly and concisely
- Ability to work independently within established boundaries escalate issues and opportunities as needed, and adapt quickly to changing circumstances
- Ability to identify the best process and/or framework to achieve the outcome sought
- Personal integrity, sound judgment, and a commitment to honesty and ethical conduct
- Good relationship building and listening skills, and political nous including the ability to understand different perspectives
- Understanding of the public sector, including how agencies work, and the broader machinery of government
