Public health guidance was published by the Ministry of Health on 17 July. 

We have closed 640 submissions and have 74 submissions awaiting closure or investigation. The latest RRT report was provided to your office on 15 July (MFR2025-192).

#### **FEC Estimates post-hearing questions**

The Finance and Expenditure Committee held a hearing for Vote Regulation on 17 June 2025 for this year's round of Budget Estimates.

The Committee has sent you post-hearing questions for response. This follows the Standard Estimates Questionnaire 2025/26 and Supplementary Written Questions which were lodged with the Committee on 23 May and 11 June, respectively. The responses will be used by the Committee as they examine the 2025/26 Estimates of Appropriations.
