Things to know before you start


- ✤ RegRoom is an online learning and collaboration space created specifically for regulators. You need to use your work email to set-up a RegRoom account and only those identified as working in regulation will be able to successfully join.
- This document is intended as a GENERAL GUIDE only the exact screens and steps you see may differ.
- You will need a second device (e.g. mobile phone, tablet) that has the MICROSOFT AUTHENTICATOR APP on it. If you don't have this app, you can learn more and download it here: <u>https://www.microsoft.com/en-</u> <u>nz/security/mobile-authenticator-app</u>

Setting up an account

1. Register

Go to https://learn.regulation.govt.nz

Select 'create a new one', indicated by the arrow below...



...and enter the **govt.nz** email address and password you use to login to your work account.



2. MFA process

Follow the Multifactor Authentication prompts.



In the Multifactor Authentication App, click the blue circle in the bottom right corner to open the inapp camera and scan the QR code.






1. Register

Go to https://learn.regulation.govt.nz

Enter your govt.nz email address:








2. MFA process (continued)

Open the authenticator app on your mobile device.


Click the blue circle in the bottom right hand corner of the app to open the in-app camera.

Scan the QR code shown on your screen:



3. Final steps

You will then see the screen as below - click 'Accept'.

You will then be prompted to review and accept or decline a site privacy policy – this should only occur on your first log in.

This policy refers to the data we collect through your log in process and how your data is tracked and used in the system. If you do not accept this, your sign in process will be aborted. If you click accept you will be taken through to the dashboard for RegRoom.

Congratulations – you are now logged in! Future log ins should only require Single Sign On (SSO).
